### A One Day Conference:

### WILHELM REICH & PSYCHOANALYSIS

The conference will explore some of Wilhelm Reich's contributions to psychoanalytic theory and technique, as well as aspects of his historical relationship with psychoanalysis, including the origins of his exclusion from the International Psychoanalytic Association.

In the morning session, Dr. Eric Weitzner will discuss Reich's contribution to psychoanalytic theory, and Dr. Jonathan Koblenzer will discuss the importance of Reich's monograph, *The Impulsive Character*, as a step in the development of Reich's most important psychoanalytic work, *Character Analysis*.

In the afternoon session, Dr. Henry Lothane will discuss Dramatology in relation to the defamation of Reich by his colleagues, and Dr. Philip W. Bennett will discuss Reich's historic visit to Soviet Russia and its connection with Reich's exclusion from the IPA. The conference will end with a roundtable discussion.

The conference is sponsored by the *Institute for the Study of the Work of Wilhelm Reich*, an educational organization founded by Dr. Harry Lewis, who will moderate the sessions.

A contribution of \$30 (\$20 for students and trainees) will be requested at the door from participants, but no one who wants to attend will be turned away.
